Thanks to a generous donation from The Long Center Foundation, all fundamental swim lessons such as Parent/Child, Learn-To-Swim Level 1 and 2 sessions will be \$10 for all children. Parent/Child Aquatics (Ages 6-36 Months)

This course emphasizes water acclimation. Parents or guardians participate in the water to support safe exploration, body positioning, and comfort in an aquatic environment for their children.



Preschool Aquatics

(Ages 3-4)

Children develop introductory water safety behaviors and pre-swimming skills through structured, age-appropriate instruction. Emphasis is placed on water adjustment, supported movement, and water safety habits.

Learn-to-Swim Level 1

(Ages 5+)

Children develop elementary aquatic competencies, including water adjustment, assisted floating, and safe entry and exit habits. Instruction focuses on establishing foundational safety behaviors and basic water skills.

Learn-to-Swim Level 2

(Ages 5+)

Children build upon Level 1 competencies by improving body control, independent movement, and foundational water skills. Instruction emphasizes increased independence, coordinated arm and leg actions, and safe water habits.

Learn-to-Swim Level 3

(Ages 6+)

Children refine water skills learned in Level 1 & 2 to achieve basic water competency. Instruction focuses on coordinated stroke actions, improved endurance, and effective movement through the water with minimal support. 30 minutes per lesson

Stroke Development – Level 4

(Ages 6+)

Participants improve proficiency in the swimming strokes and water skills. Instruction emphasizes stroke refinement, improved endurance, and greater independence in deep-water skills under the supervision of a certified instructor.

Get a Recreation Card

A Clearwater recreation card provides access to all of Clearwater's premier recreation centers, pools, athletic facilities and other recreational programs at a reduced rate or for free. By purchasing a recreation card, you can improve your physical health and well-being by staying active, engage in social activities, and meet new people who share similar interests. Recreation cards are available to residents and non-residents, and you can get one in person at any recreation center.

Types of Recreation Cards

Annual Individual Recreation Card

- Resident: \$7
- Non-Resident: \$180

Annual Family Recreation Card

- Resident: \$35
- Non-Resident: \$450

Other Specialty Recreation Cards

- Long Center Youth Card: \$60.00
- Non-Resident Disabled Veteran Discount (discount available is based on the percentage of disability)
- Non-Resident Youth Co-Sponsor Card/Family Card: \$120
- Safety Harbor Resident Youth Athletic Card: \$7.49

Drop-In Fees

All pools and fitness centers (except Long Center):

- \$2.80 (W)
- \$5.61 (W/O)

Long Center Pool:

- \$4.67 (W)
- \$9.35 (W/O)

Don't want to pay the daily drop-in fee? Add PLUS to your recreation card and pay an annual fee or month-to-month.

- PLUS Annual: \$120 first family member; \$75 each additional family member.
- PLUS Monthly: \$30

Healthcare Programs Accepted

All recreation centers accept SilverSneakers, Silver & Fit, Active & Fit, Renew Active, One Pass, and Tivity Prime. Eligible members receive an Individual Recreation Card providing free access to the recreation amenities that are not instructor-led, i.e., fitness centers, pools, and gymnasiums during hours of operation. Exclusions and restrictions may apply.

SilverSneakers members receive free access to one SilverSneakers Signature class daily. The recreation card may be used at McMullen Tennis Complex, and additional fees apply (excluding Tivity Prime members.)
