## **Clearwater Marina Tenant Outreach Group**

The Clearwater Marina Tenant Outreach Group represents the 27 Commercial Vessel Operators in the Clearwater Beach Marina. It comprises 7 Business Owners representing all types of businesses in the marina: Tours Boats/Water Sports, Dinner Boats, 6-pack Fishing Boats, and Fishing Head Boats.

**Objective:** The Tenant Outreach Group will help develop operational strategies for the commercial businesses in the marina to maximize efficiency and effectiveness within the rules, requirements, and footprint of the marina to sustain business operations, growth, and development.

The meeting started at 9:00 am and ended at 10:20 am.

The spokesperson of the Outreach group is Trisha Rodriguez, and the alternative is Chad Haggart.

- 2. The City Public Information Department is working to bring as much visibility as possible to the Beach Marina. They need vector files with current business logos from each company to publish them on the website.







- 3. The City Public Information Department is editing its fence graphics to show all businesses affected by construction and temporary business kiosk locations.
- The Tenant Outreach Group seeks signage options for the temporary slips during Phase One.
- The Tenant Outreach Group is seeking assistance with banners/signage for the barrier walls along the temporary kiosk area.
- The City Public
   Information Department seeks to identify all businesses affected during construction.






7. The City Marine and Aviation Department is looking to have the commercial tenants start moving their businesses to the east end of the marina beginning **October 1st**.

8. The City is still considering dredging material de-watering options.



- 9. The Tenant Outreach Group is working on a temporary kiosk layout to meet each business's needs.
- 10. The temporary kiosk location has a maximum of 110 Outlets/20 AMPs per kiosk available, and you will have to pay for electric usage. Also, only trailers and temporary movable items will be allowed in these areas. No anchoring to the ground is possible.



11. The Tenant Outreach Group is looking into more transportation options, including "Ava."
